## WASTE PRODUCTS TO RECYCLE

## HOW TO RECYCLE THEM? <sup>(1)</sup>

<b>Aerosol Cans</b>	- Empty & tip removed	Recycle HFL, CTS
<b>Aluminum</b>	- Cans*, plates, foil	Recycle HFL, CTS
<b>Appliances</b>	- Large metal white goods *	Recycle at CTS; HFL - Call <sup>(2)</sup>
<b>Batteries</b>	- Household - Lead Acid *	Recycle at CTS - Wednesday mornings only Recycle at Auto parts & service stores or CTS
<b>Books</b>	- Hard Cover - Paperbacks	Reuse to Commercial used book stores & libraries Reuse; Recycle with mixed paper HFL, CTS Reuse to resale stores <sup>(3)</sup>
<b>Clothes</b>		Reuse to commercial dry cleaners
<b>Clothes Hangers</b>		Recycle at CTS
<b>Cooking Oil</b>		Recycle HFL, CTS
<b>Corrugated CardBoard</b>	- Flattened	Reuse to farm markets; Recycle with mixed paper HFL, CTS
<b>Egg Cartons</b>	- Paper  - Styrofoam	Reuse to farm markets Recycle CTS - Wednesday mornings only
<b>Electronics *</b>		Compost with yard trash
<b>Food Scraps</b>		Recycle HFL, CTS
<b>Glass</b>	- Bottles * - Misc. (windows, mirrors, drinking)	Trash only Reuse to resale stores <sup>(3)</sup>
<b>Household Items</b>	- Misc. (Furniture, kitchen item.)	Recycle at Home Depot stores
<b>Light Bulbs</b>	- Compact Fluorescent (CFL) - Incandescent	Trash only Recycle at CTS
<b>Liquid Anti-freeze *</b>		Recycle at CTS
<b>Liquid Motor Oil *</b>		Recycle at CTS
<b>Newspapers</b>		Recycle HFL, CTS
<b>Oil Filters *</b>		Recycle at CTS
<b>Paint Cans</b>	- Paint evaporated out to dry	Trash only
<b>Paper – Miscellaneous:</b>	- Food wrappers, drink boxes, tissues, towels, waxpaper, dogfood bags, etc.	Trash only
<b>Paper - Mixed:</b>	- Keep dry & clean (Office, gift wrap, envelopes, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, food cartons, etc.) *	Recycle HFL, CTS
<b>Plastic</b>	- Bags - Bottles, Jars, & Jugs - Miscellaneous ( non-bottles )	Recycle at Grocery stores; Reuse to libraries Recycle HFL, CTS Trash only
<b>Rubber Tires</b>	- Auto/truck *	Recycle at CTS
<b>Shoes</b>		Reuse to resale stores <sup>(3)(4)</sup>
<b>Steel / Tin Cans</b>		Recycle HFL, CTS
<b>Styrofoam</b>		Reuse to Commercial mailing / shipping stores
<b>Wooden Pallets *</b>		Recycle at CTS
<b>Yard Trash *</b>		Compost with food scraps; Recycle HFL, CTS

### NOTES:

\* State Law [NC G.S. 130 A - 309.10(f)] - Bans specific waste items from landfill disposal (Electronics in 2011)

1) HFL - City of Hendersonville & Town of Fletcher pickup by Curbside Management; Town of Laurel Park pickup by GDS Services;

CTS - All county areas - private pickup service or personal delivery to county transfer station on Stoney Mountain Road

2) Public Works Offices: Hendersonville: 697-3084, Fletcher: 654-9208, Laurel Park: 693-4840, Flat Rock: 697-8461

3) Non-profit resale stores: The Salvation Army, Goodwill, Hospice, churches, etc.
